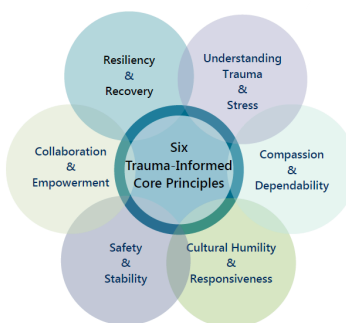


NFI North is your complete resource for mental and behavioral health care services that support children, adults, seniors, and families across Maine and New Hampshire.

New Hampshire Individual Service Options (ISO) serves New Hampshire's children and their families with multiple behavioral and emotional health needs referred by the Division for Children, Youth and Families (DCYF or DJJS).

The Individual Service Options (ISO) goal is to promote family self-sufficiency, to connect families to support and provide resources within the community. Our highly trained staff provides support and education for families within a structured, nurturing environment for optimal growth. Youth and families are an integral part of the treatment team and are empowered to take an active role in their treatment. The agency embraces the New Hampshire System of Care values and customizes services to meet the specific needs of each family. These values include strength-based, family and youth driven, trauma informed and a culturally competent approach.

Through evidence-based practices, NFI North builds upon the strengths of each unique family they support through ISO In-Home, Foster Care, or Home-Based Therapeutic Services (HBTS) resulting in improved outcomes for families. Our goal is to prevent any type of out-of-home service such as residential-based treatment for children who are working through significant trauma, whenever possible. ISO services also help children and youth transitioning back home to their community from an alternative living situation. These services may include case management, home-based counseling, intensive in-home or on-call support.

NFI has been providing ISO Services in New Hampshire since 2009 and the mission is to inspire and empower people to achieve their full potential so they can live successfully in their home and community.
